


Academic Success

Success by Student Group


This display shows PARCC performance levels for each student group. No data is shown for groups with fewer than 10 students.







School Highlights

Academic Courses

Our goal is to prepare students to take honors and AP courses at the high school level. Art, Bilingual Programs/Courses, Character Counts, College Exploration, Peer Mentors, Socratic Seminars, Summer School, Supplemental Educational Services (SES) Tutoring, and Title 1 Programs are offered.

Physical Education, Health and Wellness

Irving offers both physical education and health classes. Irving participates in the Healthy Schools Program, the 2013 Bears Play 60 Challenge, and the Chicago Fire Soccer Team school program.

Other Programs and Activities

9th Grade Transition, Chess, Girl Scouts, IMSA, Poetry, PTO, Student Council, Tutoring, & Young Authors. Irving partners with United Methodist Church for 3rd grade tutoring, WCMI for Teacher Development, Westlake Hospital for Healthy Taste Tests, and Comcast Cares Day.

Career Development Courses and Programs
